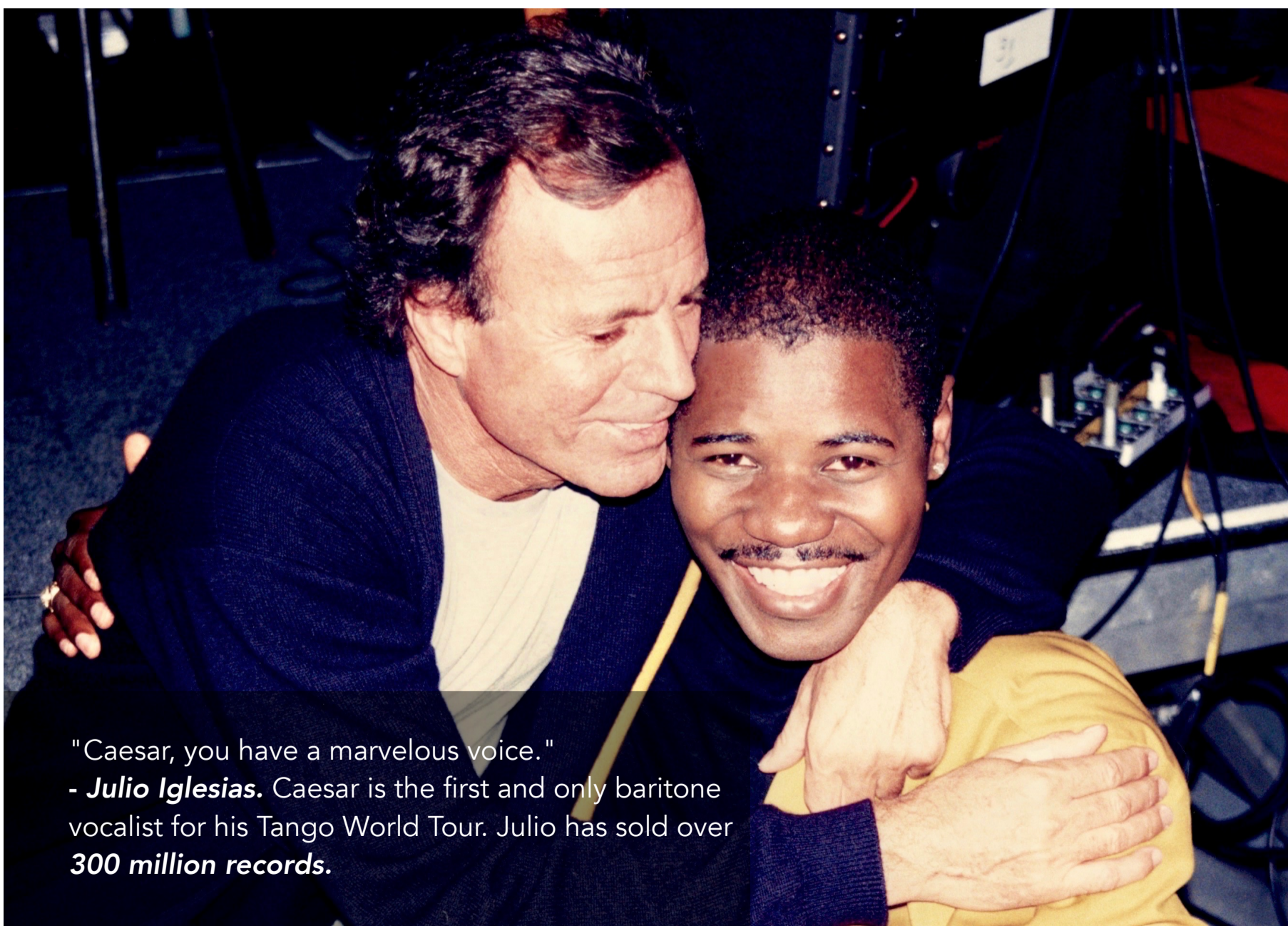

Caesar is a cancer survivor. His team of Harvard-educated doctors at Massachusetts General Hospital informed him that he risked losing his voice or hearing due to the treatments he was undergoing.
